

Important FEMA Information

It is very important that if you have damages caused from the recent disaster that you register with FEMA as soon as possible. In a few days, a Disaster Recovery Center (DRC) will be opened in Johnson County for those with damages to meet with FEMA and apply for assistance. Registering now will speed that process up.

Below is the information that you need to apply/register with FEMA:

- Your Social Security number.
- Current and pre-disaster address.
- A telephone number where you can be contacted.
- Insurance information.
- Total household annual income
- A routing and account number from your bank (only necessary if you want to have disaster assistance funds transferred directly into your bank account)
- A description of your losses that were caused by the disaster.

After you have completed your application for assistance you will receive a FEMA application number. Write down this number for future reference.
